

In the existing ISA's governance, what is the difference between the "ISA Hong Kong Chapter" and affiliate organization "ISA HK/China Station"?

The primary difference between these two entities is the formality of the relationship with ISA. The Chapter relationship develops as an organization grows within a geographic region.

There are a few specific requirements of ISA chapters, including:

- ◆ Governance structure and the related documents (管治架構及憲章),
- ◆ Member elected Board of Directors,
- ◆ Annual submission of financial statements,
- ◆ Minimum requirement of 50 ISA members within that region,
- ◆ A voting seat within the Council of Representatives (ISA 議會代表),
- ◆ Increase in the shared revenue generated through the ISA credential program for development of new and ongoing educational programs to service members and credential holders in that region,
- ◆ Utilize ISA trademarks to formally demonstrate the relationship between the Chapter and ISA

Approved Chapter Board Structure Highlights

- ◆ For the 1st and 2nd year Chapter operation, all the officers, Board members and Chairs of the Standing Committees of the Chapter will be nominated, appointed, and approved by the SC with an additional approval by the ISA Headquarter.
- ◆ The President will assume the role of the Chairman of the Board.
- ◆ ISA Council Representative (ISA 議會代表) and Public Board member (公眾理事委員) are not eligible to run for the Vice-president.
- ◆ Public Board member, to be nominated, appointed and approved within (30) days by the new Board, does not have the right to vote.
- ◆ Starting from Year 3, new Board members election will be held at two years interval (For example, in Year 3, Year 5, Year 7, Year 9).
- ◆ Starting from Year 3, there will be an election for the Vice-president in the Board every year.
- ◆ In case the Quorum of a new Board cannot be maintained to eleven (11) voting members. The recent Past President should retain in the new Board as a voting Board member (For example in Year 4, Year 6, Year 8)

Approved Chapter Board Structure Highlights

- ◆ Terms of service of a general Board member are two (2) years, can serve two consecutive terms (i.e. Four (4) years consecutively). After that the Board member has to step down from the Board for one term before he / she can be nominated as a Board member candidate again.
- ◆ Terms of service of an ISA Chapter Representative are three (3) years, can serve two consecutive terms (i.e. Six (6) years consecutively). After that an ISA Chapter Representative has to step down from the Board for one term before he / she can be nominated as an ISA Chapter Representative candidate again.
- ◆ Terms of service of Vice-president, President-elect, President, Past-president are four (4) years. They can serve a maximum of two terms, but not in consecutive terms (except the Past-president when he / she is required to complete the Quorum. For example in Year 4, Year 6, Year 8).
- ◆ Terms of service (Public Board member): One (1) year term, appointed and approved by the new Board, can serve consecutive terms.
- ◆ Nomination committee shall ensure sufficient board diversity can be maintained in the Board. Not more than two (2) new board member candidates shall come from the same category on the ballot slate.
- ◆ The size of the Board includes eleven (11) voting members and one (1) non-voting member.

Standing / Functional Committees

Similar to other ISA Chapters, numbers of standing / functional committees will be formed to serve the members. For example

- ◆ Membership committee
- ◆ Certification committee
- ◆ Editorial committee
- ◆ Nomination committee
- ◆ Finance committee
- ◆ Tree Climbing Competition committee

Apart from these, many other committees will be formed to address the needs of the members in the region.



ISA Certified Arborist

Minimum Requirements

Three years of full-time experience in arboriculture, or

Two-year degree in arboriculture and two years of practical experience, or

Four-year degree in related field and one year of practical experience

Examination Format

3.5 hours to complete 200 multiple-choice questions which are drawn from the question bank, passing score is 72%

How the Examination Was Developed

The certification examination was developed by a panel of industry experts representing all aspects of arboriculture. Questions were derived from a job analysis survey from around the world. Questions are constantly analyzed by the ISA Certification Test Committee and new questions are always being developed. Questions that do not perform satisfactorily are removed from the question bank. New examinations are created on a regular basis.

Recertification

Valid for three (3) years. To maintain the certification, a credential holder must earn 30 continuing education units (CEUs) by the end of that three-year period and pay the recertification fee, and signed the Code of Ethics document

ISA Certified Tree Worker Climber Specialist

Minimum Requirements

18 months of climbing experience in arboriculture

Examination Format

1.5 hours to complete 50 multiple-choice questions (passing score is 70%) and a skill examination (passing score is 80%)

How the Examination Was Developed

The certification examination was developed by a panel of industry experts representing all aspects of arboriculture. Questions were derived from a job analysis survey from around the world. Questions are constantly analyzed by the ISA Certification Test Committee and new questions are always being developed. Questions that do not perform satisfactorily are removed from the question bank. New examinations are created on a regular basis.

Recertification

Valid for three (3) years. To maintain the certification, a credential holder must earn 15 continuing education units (CEUs) by the end of that three-year period, proof of training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and first aid and pay the recertification fee.

ISA Board Certified Master Arborist

Minimum Requirements

Must be an ISA Certified Arborist in good standing and have obtained a total of (8) eight points from any or all of the four categories that include measurable experience, formal education, related credentials, or professional experience.

Examination Format

4 hours to complete 165 scenario-based questions. Following each scenario are one to twenty questions about the scenario or related specific arboricultural knowledge. (passing score is 75%)

How the Examination Was Developed

The advanced certification examination was developed by a panel of industry experts representing all aspects of arboriculture. Questions were derived from a job analysis survey from around the United States and Canada. Questions are constantly analyzed by the BCMA test committee and new questions are always being developed. Questions that do not perform satisfactorily are removed from the question bank. New examinations are created on a regular basis.

Recertification

Valid for three (3) years. To maintain the certification, a credential holder must earn 60 continuing education units (CEUs) by the end of that three-year period.

Tree Risk Assessment Course & Exam (TRACE) & Tree Risk Assessment Qualification (TRAQ)

TRACE organized by the Pacific Northwest ISA is a training course for the assessment of trees in urban areas and in the urban/rural interface areas. The course is now being offered in the Pacific Northwest ISA.

Per an agreement with the International Society of Arboriculture, the Pacific Northwest ISA will stop holding TRACE courses in the PNW-ISA's US region as of February 1, 2013. TRACE certificate holders with a valid expiration date as of then will be automatically assimilated into the new ISA Tree Risk Assessment Qualification (TRAQ) program.

ISA will be launching a new qualifications program, the Tree Risk Assessment Qualification (TRAQ) in March 2013. The qualifications platform is different from ISA's current certification credentials, because it requires a classroom education component that participants must complete before they can take the qualifications exam.
